AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 TO ALLOCATE RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTAL AND CAPITAL BUDGETS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has had additional receipts and expenditures across various departments differing from the adopted budget for FY23; and

WHEREAS the City has approved several employee retention and recruitment programs that require allocation of budget dollars to implement said programs; and

WHEREAS the City has identified fund balance dollars remaining at end of FY2022 for reallocation to the set-asides for emergency preparedness, resurfacing, six-month operating reserves and capital; and


WHEREAS the City has approved certain moratorium studies that require reallocation of budget dollars between departments; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the FY23 budget to reflect receipts, expenditures and reallocations.


