## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 135**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH REFLECTIONS OF TRINITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$67,862 TO PERFORM FOOD DISTRIBUTION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously approved agreements with GoodR and Reflections of Trinity in Resolution 2022 – 074 to support families and individuals in Powder Springs who were experiencing food insecurity and set aside funding from its American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") grant for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, after completing several ARPA projects under budget, the City approved renewal of the agreements with Reflections of Trinity and GoodR by Resolution 2023-227 but subsequently learned that GoodR would be unable to renew the agreement without an increase beyond an amount that required competitive re-bidding; and

**WHEREAS** the City notified both parties of its intent to seek proposals and thereafter requested proposals for distribution of food through conclusion of the 2025-2026 school year; and

**WHEREAS** Reflections of Trinity proposed services at a cost of \$67,862, and the City desires to accept and approve said proposal.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Reflections of Trinity in the amount of \$67,862 to continue the grocery food distribution services for residents of Powder Springs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
