RESOLUTION 2018-025

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,399.90 FOR CLEAN UP AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAILS AND PARKS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS IMPACTED BY THE WINTER STORMS WITH FALLEN TREES AND LIMBS, WATER OBSTRUCTION AND BRUSH GROWTH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City's public grounds suffered from snow and ice storms in December and January with fallen trees, limbs and water obstruction along the City's trails and in the City's parks, which have not been removed because of excessive rainfall and ongoing concentrated efforts to remove similar materials from roadsides throughout the City:

WHEREAS, regular right of way and public grounds maintenance is underway and continues to prevent removal and maintenance activities along the trails and in the parks, compromising the public's use of these recreational amenities;

WHEREAS, the City solicited quotes to remove the trees, limbs and water obstruction and it desires to authorize the City Manager and Parks and Recreation Director to accept the lowest responsive and responsible quote for removal activities using contingency funds in an amount not to exceed \$32,399.90;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the City Manager and Parks & Recreation Director to accept the lowest responsive and responsible quote for an amount not to exceed \$32,399.90 to remove trees, excessive growth and brush and water obstruction along the City trails and parks, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
