WHEREAS the Department of Transportation are soliciting applications for Safe Streets and Roads; and

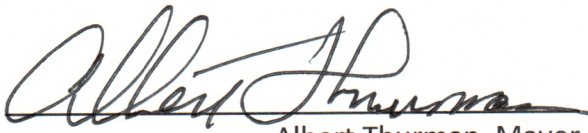
