A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE NEW AND UPDATED CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE (LCI) PLAN; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the Livable Centers Initiative (“LCI”) is a program of the Atlanta Regional Commission that encourages local jurisdictions to plan and implement strategies that link transportation improvements with land use strategies to create sustainable, livable and walkable communities consistent with regional development policies; and

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) previously prepared and adopted an LCI plan for its downtown initially in 2024 and subsequently updated the plan in 2016 and thereafter applied for planning funds to both update and create a new plan in 2026 to consider the redevelopment that has occurred in the last decade; and


WHEREAS the 2026 plan and update was developed through a process that engaged the public with multiple opportunities to shape recommendations, and the City desires to approve and adopt the recommendations resulting from this study update and community outreach.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and adopts the 2026 major updates to its LCI Plan and authorizes its consultant to submit the final plan to the Atlanta Regional Commission upon adoption.


