AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATE MONIES FROM GENERAL FUND USE OF FUND BALANCE TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR CITY-WIDE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City previously approved the rebrand of the City's logo and guidelines for the use of the new brand and logo, including use in upgrades to the City's existing sign program;

WHEREAS, the City solicited and obtained bids to design trail and downtown signage and thereafter to design, manufacture and install renovated and expanded city-wide signage, and the City desires to appropriate fund balance reserves to the capital projects fund to upgrade the City's signage program;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2019 be amended as provided in the attached;






