A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN INTERIM POLICE CHIEF; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, The Powder Springs Police Department is under the direction of a Chief of Police whose duties are defined under the Code of Ordinances of the City of Powder Springs, Georgia;

WHEREAS, current Interim Chief of Police Charles Sewell has provided notice of resignation, effective August 27, 2017;

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends the appointment of Lieutenant Detective Lane Cadwell to serve as Chief of Police beginning August 28, 2017 and continuing thereafter until such time as a permanent replacement is appointed, and the Mayor and Council desire to approve the recommendation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that Lieutenant Detective Lane Cadwell is hereby appointed to be Chief of Police for which he will receive a salary of \$87,720.00. This appointment shall be effective August 28, 2017 and continue until such time as a permanent Chief of Police is appointed.






