A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 1500 SANITATION CARTS AT A COST OF \$96,050.64; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") has need for and has requested and received quotes to initiate a replacement program of sanitation carts that are on average dated by more than twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the City will begin with 1500 replacements in this fiscal year using sanitation fund balance:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs finds Toter to be the lowest responsible and responsive bidder with a total bid in the amount of \$96,050.64;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid of Toter for 1500 new sanitation carts in the amount of \$96,050.64 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER resolved that the Finance Director shall prepare a budget amendment reflecting the use of sanitation fund balance dollars in the replacement of said carts. This Resolution shall take effect upon approval.
