A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 1500 SANITATION CARTS AT A COST OF \$96,050.64; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs ("City") has need for and has requested and received quotes to initiate a replacement program of sanitation carts that are on average dated by more than twenty years; and


**WHEREAS**, the City will begin with 1500 replacements in this fiscal year using sanitation fund balance;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs finds Toter to be the lowest responsible and responsive bidder with a total bid in the amount of \$96,050.64;


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid of Toter for 1500 new sanitation carts in the amount of \$96,050.64 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER** resolved that the Finance Director shall prepare a budget amendment reflecting the use of sanitation fund balance dollars in the replacement of said carts. This Resolution shall take effect upon approval.

**SO RESOLVED** this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2022.




