

RESOLUTION 2018 - 067

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MUTUAL NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT WITH CELLCO PARTNERSHIP, D/B/A VERIZON WIRELESS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless (hereinafter, "Verizon"), is undertaking efforts to deploy small cell wireless facilities in certain jurisdictions in the metropolitan Atlanta area and in furtherance of such endeavor is interested in meeting with the City of Powder Springs to discuss its proposed facilities and a possible agreement for the installation of such facilities; and


WHEREAS, Verizon has notified the City that such a meeting is likely to entail the disclosure of confidential information in the nature of proprietary information and/or trade secrets, and in order to facilitate such a meeting, Verizon requires the entry of Mutual Nondisclosure Agreement as a prerequisite to such meeting; and


