

RESOLUTION 2022 - 148

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER WITH CMC, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$11,625.72; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR AND DEVELOPMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS TO CLOSE OUT THE FLORENCE ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“City”) previously authorized CMC, Inc. to complete intersection improvements at Florence Road and US278 under the 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax program (the “Project”); and


WHEREAS CMC, Inc. has completed the Project under the budgeted amount and submitted a deductive change order for approval and execution by the City;

WHEREAS the City desires to accept and approve the change order and close out the Project;


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute a deductive change order with CMC, Inc. for an amount of \$11,625.72 and authorizes the Public Works Director and Development & Infrastructure Agency Director to execute all documents needed to close out the Project, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.






