A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EAST COAST GRADING TO CLOSE OUT THE 2024 RESURFACING PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$68,463.43; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs previously authorized East Coast Grading to resurface Bridle Court, Brittany Drive, Hopeland Court, Lawler Drive, Macedonia Drive, McNeel Industrial Way, Ten Oaks Court, Wager Court, Frank Aiken Road, New Towne Drive, Saddleridge Road, Spring Industrial Drive, Lockerbie Lane, Integrity Way and Forest Hill Road under the City's Georgia Department of Transportation Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) funds, its Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax ("SPLOST") funds and its general fund resurfacing dollars in the amount of \$1,754,193.47 under Resolution 2024-032 (the "2024 Resurfacing Project"); and

WHEREAS East Coast has completed the 2024 Resurfacing Project and has submitted a deductive change order to close said project.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute a deductive change order to the agreement with East Coast Grading for an amount of \$68,463.43 and close out the 2024 Resurfacing Project.
