## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 048**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH VC3 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF A MODERN OFFICE ADVANTAGE FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$56,365.54; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") currently utilizes a virtual office environment through its Master Services Agreement with its Information Technology provider, VC3, allowing employees holding positions that can be performed offsite the ability to provide services from the remote location in a safe and secure manner;

**WHEREAS**, to provide greater mobility and cost savings, VC3 recommends the virtual office option with the use of mobile devices rather than hosted desktops;

WHEREAS, VC3 proposes to support mobile option for a one time cost of \$56,365.54 in the current fiscal year and a corresponding decrease in costs in subsequent fiscal years;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an amendment to the Agreement with VC3 to replace desktops with docking stations and mobile laptops and other services as described in the attached amendment identified as Exhibit A for a one-time cost of \$56,365.34, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
