
A RESOLUTION DECLARING AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION OF SANITATION CARTS AND LIFE CYCLE DEPLETED TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interest of the City to declare as surplus and dispose of or sell said property.






