
A RESOLUTION DECLARING AS SURPLUS THIRTY-FOUR (34) SANITATION CARTS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR SALE OR DISPOSAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder in its Public Works Department has thirty-four (34) residential sanitation carts which are not currently being used and which are no longer serviceable for municipal purposes given their age and condition; and


WHEREAS, such carts have little or no present value, and the Mayor and Council deem it appropriate to declare same as surplus and authorize their disposal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the thirty-four (34) sanitation carts identified herein are no longer serviceable for municipal purposes and are hereby declared to be surplus, and the disposition of same is hereby authorized as provided by law. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


