
WHEREAS these software programs are essential for efficient service delivery, internal communications, project management, permitting, data analysis, and other operational needs; and


WHEREAS the acquisition and renewal of such software programs have been reviewed and included in the approved fiscal year budget; and





SO RESOLVED AND EFFECTIVE this 6th day of October 2025.






