A RESOLUTION RENEWING AN AGREEMENT WITH DATAWORKS PLUS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000 FOR RAPID IDENTIFICATION DEVICE SERVICE SUPPORT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, DataWorks Plus provides law enforcement and criminal justice technology for law enforcement agencies by developing and building software and hardware for products to improve the productivity, efficiency, and the safety of officers and other agency staff, including a system that provides fast and accurate solutions using advanced fingerprinting techniques for positive identification called RAPID-ID;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs has a Rapid ID Device Support Agreement with DataWorks that it desires to renew in order to receive ongoing maintenance of software used by the Police Department in its daily functions;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the renewal agreement submitted by DataWorks for an amount not to exceed \$2,000 for annual maintenance services of the City's RAPID-ID system, and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with DataWorks, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
