

RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 103


A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY FROM JULY 26 THROUGH JULY 28 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMMODATING A TEMPORARY OUTREACH EVENT HOSTED BY CALVARY CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HOPKINS ROAD AND HOPKINS COURT IF DETERMINED NECESSARY BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MANAGE TRAFFIC CONTROL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Calvary Christian Ministries has applied for a permit to host a Church Tent Revival and community cookout on property owned by the City of Powder Springs ("City") fronting Hopkins Road across from Hopkins Court, which may require the temporary closure of both roadways for traffic control measures; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to accommodate said event; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the use of public property and the temporary road closure or other traffic control measures on Hopkins Road and Hopkins Court on Friday, July 26 between 7:00pm and 9:00pm, Saturday, July 27 between 4:00pm – 9:00pm and Sunday, July 28 between 10:00am and 2:00pm to accommodate a Church Tent Revival and community cookout hosted by Calvary Christian Ministries. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


