A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION AGREEMENT WITH UTILITIES PROTECTION CENTER, LLC D/B/A GEORGIA 811 APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP WITH GEORGIA 811 FOR AN INTIAL APPLICATION FEE OF \$200 AND \$1.42 PER TICKET AND THEREAFTER AN ANNUAL LIMITED MEMBERSHIP FEE OF \$25; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“City”) owns certain streetlights along city roads that it desires to locate prior to any excavation activity in the vicinity of said lights; and


WHEREAS Georgia 811 is a communication system that notifies member companies about proposed excavations so that the member company can locate its underground resource to prevent damage to the resource and to promote public safety; and


WHEREAS the City desires to apply for membership with Georgia 811 so that the city has an opportunity to locate and identify its street light resources in an area where excavation is planned.


