

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-136

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STREETS IN THE VICINITY OF TOWN SQUARE AS PART OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S NATIONAL NIGHT OUT EVENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Powder Springs Police Department is hosting its National Night Out event on October 2, 2018 in and around Town Square; and

WHEREAS, National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make neighborhoods safer, more caring places to live and enhances the relationship between citizens and law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, order to conduct the event and to help ensure the safety of attendees, it will be necessary to close the following City streets from 3:00 PM until 9:00 PM on October 2, 2018:

Oakview Drive from Marietta Street to Jackson Way Extension
Pineview Drive from Marietta Street to Jackson Way Extension
North Town Square from Pineview Drive to Oakview Drive
South Town Square from Pineview Drive to Oakview Drive


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs exercise control over the city streets and wish to provide for the temporary street closures needed to accommodate the National Night Out event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the following City streets will be closed from 3:00 PM until 9:00 PM on October 2, 2018:

Oakview Drive from Marietta Street to Jackson Way Extension
Pineview Drive from Marietta Street to Jackson Way Extension
North Town Square from Pineview Drive to Oakview Drive
South Town Square from Pineview Drive to Oakview Drive

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


