

RESOLUTION 2021 - 115

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING FOR A SUM OF \$11,000 TO COMPLETE ENGINEERING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS TO REPAIR A FAILED DETENTION POND IN THE PINEBLUFF SUBDIVISION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) Community Development Department has identified deficiencies in a detention pond within the Pinebluff subdivision that requires repairs and upgrades; and


WHEREAS, the City must determine the scope of needed repairs in order to require the property owner(s) to complete said repairs, and the City desires to engage Croy Engineering to assess the extent of failure and damage and specify needed repairs to the detention pond;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Croy Engineering for a sum of \$11,000 to complete an assessment of the detention pond in Pinebluff subdivision and prepare the necessary engineering plans and specifications to complete repairs of the pond, subject to review and approval of the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


