### **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING GUIDELINES RELATING TO THE RENTAL AND USE OF THURMAN SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs ("City") recently completed and accepted for maintenance and programming a public park in the heart of downtown that includes amenities such as a splash pad, amphitheater, trail head, lighting, landscaping and a trailhead connecting to the Silver Comet Trail and the City's Lucille and Wild Horse Trails, and more ("Thurman Springs Park"); and


