

## RESOLUTION NO. 2020-151

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER WITH DESIGNATED CLIPPER, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,446.50 RELATING TO THE FENCING PROJECT WITHIN THE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS LOCATED ON HOPKINS ROAD AND LANCER DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (hereinafter "the City") previously authorized Designated Clipper LLC to install fencing within the neighborhood parks on Hopkins Road and Lancer Drive under the recreational component of the 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (hereinafter "SPLOST") program; and

**WHEREAS**, Designated Clipper, LLC has completed said project below the approved contract price and has submitted a deductive change order to close out said project, and the City desires to accept the change order;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it directs the City Manager to take steps necessary to close said project and approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a deductive change order with Designated Clipper, LLC in an amount of \$15,446.50, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


