

Resolution No. 2020 - 153

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DUE WEST BUILDERS TO COMPLETE CERTAIN BARRIER SEPARATIONS IN SHARED OFFICE SPACE USING FUNDING PROVIDED TO THE CITY BY COBB COUNTY UNDER THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City"), Cobb County, the state of Georgia and the United States has experienced an event of critical significance as a result of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Executive Order of the Governor for the State of Georgia and consistent with the guidelines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and the Department of Public Health, the City previously completed physical barriers at the reception areas of City Hall and Community Development to achieve physical separation employees and other employees and the public as a result of COVID-19;


WHEREAS, as a result of COVID-19 and due to the inability to maintain recommended social distancing without the physical barriers the City desires to install physical barriers and reconfigure office space to achieve separation between employees sharing space within the City's parks and recreation department, and Due West has submitted its change order to complete said work;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the proposal by Due West Builders to complete separation and reconfiguration of open space shared by the employees of the Parks and Recreation Department for an amount of \$18,500 using funding provided to the City by Cobb County under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.


