**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTER FOR TESTING AND ENGINEERING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE FUEL DISPENSING SYSTEM AT THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,810.76; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the fuel dispensing system located at the City of Powder Springs Public Works Department is damaged, fails to comply with code, overflows with water and unable to properly dispense fuel;


**WHEREAS**, quotes were solicited and obtained and the City desires to accept the quote submitted by the Center for Testing and Engineering ("CTE") to replace and upgrade the system, which was deemed the lowest responsive quote and in the best interest of public health and welfare;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with CTE to replace and upgrade the fuel dispensing system for an amount of \$43,810.76. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




