A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY FOR FLEET MAINTENANCE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City is a Georgia municipal corporation authorized by its Charter to provide for the acquisition of property, which would include motor vehicles and other motorized equipment, and to provide for the preservation and protection of such property and equipment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such authority, the City through its Public Works Department performs fleet management services to provide for the maintenance, repair, fueling, replacement acquisition and disposal of City vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the County operates a Fleet Management Department which has been nationally recognized for its excellence and has the capacity to provide fleet maintenance of City vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section III, Paragraph I, of the Georgia Constitution authorizes both the City and the County to enter into a contract for any period not exceeding 50 years for joint services, for the provision of services, or for the joint or separate use of facilities as long as such contracts deal with activities, services, or facilities which the contracting parties are authorized by law to undertake or provide; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interests of its citizens in the interest of efficient and cost-effective government to avail itself of the fleet maintenance services of the County by way of an intergovernmental agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement Cobb County for fleet maintenance services of the County, after review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
