

Resolution No. 2020-174

A RESOLUTION TRANSMITTING TO THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS THE ANNUAL UPDATE OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT ELEMENT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND SHORT TERM WORK PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD 2021 TO 2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has prepared an annual update to the Comprehensive Plan Capital Improvement Element ("CIE") and Short Term Work Program ("STWP") for the period 2021-2025;

WHEREAS, the annual update of the CIE and STWP was prepared in accordance with the Development Impact Fee Compliance Requirements and the Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning established by the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, and a Public Hearing was held on November 2, 2020;


WHEREAS, said update and program are subject to review by the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs prior to the City's adoption;
